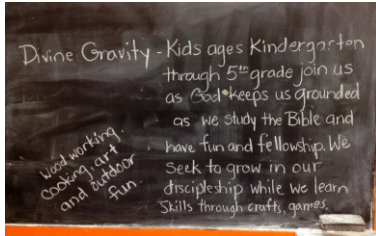

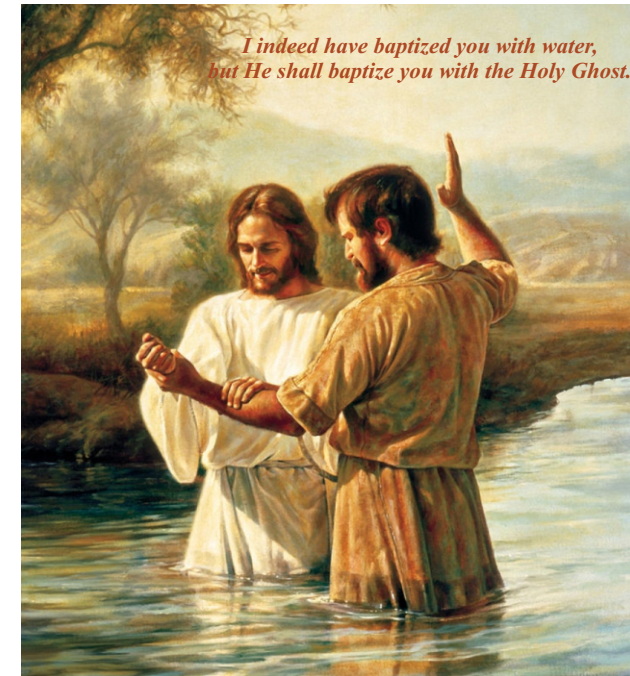
CHILDREN'S CHURCH
